Wish list of Projects for Rusthall and Tunbridge Wells Commons

This list comprises a range of projects of different scope, together with approximate costs. Most of these projects will not take place without extra funding..

- 1. Cut back scrub at the top of the steep bank adjacent to the A26 between Sainsbury's roundabout and Major York's roundabout to allow maintenance of the bank with hedging flail, reduce risk and re-expose all traffic signs. £3,500
- 2. Widenthe racecourse. Cut back scrub and saplings to create a series of scallops in the woodland edge in accordance with project 6.3 in the management plan. £12,000
- 3. Improve the path from Brighton Lake to the Terrace Walk. Widen the existing path to allow light penetration and encourage grass. Improve drainage at the top of the path and install steps on the steep section. £3,500
- re-expose the rock faces and bring in specialist contractor to remove the remaining graffiti from the main rock face. £2,000

4. Clear scrub and graffiti from Edgcumbe Rocks; remove bramble, ivy and scrub to

- 5. Increase levels of roadside tree cutting accelerate the current programme to push back and scallop all roadside woodland edge in accordance with project 6.5 in the management plan and to reduce liability. £3,000 per week

 10. Improvements to the Terrace Walk. Scallop the woodland edge on the south side

of the path to increase safety and enhance the habitat for invertebrates, in

- accordance with project 6.3 in the management plan. £4,500
- 11. Design of new logo for letter headings, signage, website etc. £500
